Meeting Opens

The First Coast Area Service Committee (ASC) met Saturday, February 12, 2010 at The Shepherd of the Woods Lutheran Church; 7860 Southside Boulevard Jacksonville, FL 32256.

Auditorium A/B main hospital. Turn left when you enter the property – we are NOT in the place we used to meet (Roger Main building).

The meeting was called to order at 11:00 a.m. and opened with a moment of silence followed by the Service Prayer. The 12 Traditions and 12 Concepts were read. The floor was opened to anyone wanting to address the First Coast Area.

<u>Announcement:</u> The ASC Chair announced the Pastor of the facility used heavily by groups and subcommittees wanted to meet at 2pm to review the ground rules for the usage of both the Southside and Lakeshore properties at 2pm AFTER the ASC meeting closed.

Note: This meeting did take place at 2pm AFTER the ASC closed and SOTW discussed the following:

- 1. NA is welcome to continue to use the facilities even though there have been an increase of incidents recently with both false alarms for fire alarms and violence on the property
- 2. Continue to properly request use of the facilities through the Church administrator so that space use conflicts can be prevented and that appropriate awareness can assist with fire, police, and insurance issues that may arise
- Limit anyone wandering around the building outside the approved "event" location
- 4. Take responsibility to appropriately manage violent and disruptive behavior of anyone in attendance both inside and outside the building while on the property
- 5. Children are to be supervised when on the premises suggestions were discussed as to a room that might be used for kids to hang out with supervision
- 6. Fire Alarm, Temperature Settings, and Light out were also discussed with procedures needed
- 7. The Pastor suggested that the SOTW location at the Lakeshore could be considered as an alternate location to meet during March & April during the space conflict with out ASC business meeting. This will be researched by members and information returned to the ASC Chair for an alternate consideration in the next 10 days. There are both classrooms and a flexible sanctuary with movable chairs and a kitchen that could easily handle our business meeting. The acoustics are a lot better.


