Dear Members of the Florida Region,

Your guidance is greatly needed and appreciated, as the First Coast Area appears to be experiencing a lack of commitment amongst all its services. To date many positions have been open and we have been operating as what some have termed the "Ghost Coast".

In some of my conversations with current and former groups, I received the following responses about the area (in no particular order):

- Felt like there is not a lot of disunity in the First Coast Area and thinks the convention is divisive.
- Violence on the area floor, not conducive to newcomers, thinks First Coast Area serves the convention and not the groups.
- First Coast Area is too long with too much arguing; fights almost broke out, scary.
- Thinks the First Coast Area policy package should be burnt and start over.
- Changed for geographical reasons.
- Came to area to address issues repeatedly but did not feel like they were being served.
- Fold the area and start all over in a couple of months.

At this time, the First Coast Area is going through our Nominations and Elections process. It appears slow rolling but I am keeping the faith that members will show up with the willingness to hold a commitment to service in order to further our message of hope to the addict who still suffers.

Suggestions the First Coast Area will be attempting to accomplish are a Spiritual Area Inventory, and to work towards reducing expenses. As of May 2012, our starting balance was \$10,633.07. Minus our convention seed money of \$4500.00 and our \$1200.00 prudent reserve, we are left with \$4917.07. The groups continue to hold on to these funds, as there is an overall fear that without these funds we would be operating in the red. For the past year, 10 out of 12 months we have operated beyond our means spending more than what is brought in by 7th Tradition donations.

At this time, the First Coast Area Convention originally scheduled for this year September has been canceled, as we were able to cancel the contract with the hotel. I have attempted to reach the convention chair multiple times with no avail, as I am sure some members have already pre-registered and the topic of refunds has not been addressed on the area floor yet. More will be revealed.

Helpline is still answering phone calls with seven active members from Serenity Coast. The area is currently voting on a motion to direct the Helpline to research three bids in order to reduce their current monthly cost of \$225.00.

H&I continue to need women to take presentations into lock down facilities. It is my understanding both the chair and vice chair will be stepping down at the end of their terms.

PR continues to meet without a chair. The subcommittee wants to plan a Poster Drive but without the single point of accountability of a chair, they are waiting to do so.

My contact information is on the regional contact sheet and requests any feedback. I have asked the facilitators of the region for their participation during our Spiritual Area Inventory. Date to be determined.
