Report to FL Region at July RSC:

Dear Florida Region,

First Coast Area has met twice since the last RSC, most recently yesterday Saturday 7-14-2012 with 20 groups present. I have been encouraged by my area to clarify my last report as the First Coast area is coming together. A few members expressed that my last report to the region appeared to be of my own opinion as opposed to the area's conscience. In my last report to the region I used language such as "ghost coast" in reference to many open positions and stated that the convention had been cancelled, as well as included information regarding the views of NA members about the First Coast Area before bringing this info back to First Coast first. At the June area business meeting the convention committee informed the groups that the convention "Against All Odds" has not been cancelled, rather it has been rescheduled to October 26-28th 2012 and is to be held at the downtown Wyndham Jacksonville River walk. I have

learned it is my responsibility to bring all information back to my area first in order to properly represent my area's conscience.

The First Coast Area has made a \$1,000.00 donation to the Florida Region today. Currently we have an ad-hoc committee formed to research incorporating and getting 501C3 under the Regions umbrella. As a member of the ad-hoc I have been asked to request copies of all Area's policy packages in FL Region for the purpose of establishing guidelines for board members (who, position time frames, duties, etc.).

First Coast Area has a motion going back to the groups to form an ad-hoc to begin the process of revamping our policy package to better serve the area.
